Maths Interventions at Grace Academy

Following your child's recent Mock 1 GCSE Maths results, we are writing to inform you that your child has been identified as being very close to achieving a pass grade. This places them in a critical position; with the right support and commitment over the next three months, there is a strong opportunity for them to secure a Grade 4 or above. Without this additional support, however, there is a significant risk that they may narrowly miss the pass standard.

To maximise your child's chances of success, the school is providing free, targeted Maths intervention sessions and we are strongly urging your child to attend regularly on a **Wednesday lunchtime in Rooms 1090 and 1083**.

These sessions are carefully designed to focus on exactly what your child needs to improve:

- Re-teaching key topics where marks are currently being lost;
- Practising GCSE exam-style questions;
- Improving exam technique, confidence, and accuracy.

This additional support is being offered free of charge by the school to give your child the very best possible chance of passing GCSE Maths. The coming weeks are a crucial window for improvement, and the effort made now will have a direct and lasting impact on your child's final GCSE result. We cannot stress strongly enough how important regular attendance at these sessions will be. Students in similar positions who attend intervention consistently achieve the difference between a Grade 3 and a Grade 4. Missing these sessions could mean missing a valuable opportunity to secure a pass.

This invitation has been issued because we genuinely believe that your child can succeed with the right guidance, structured practice, and commitment. We therefore ask for your full support in ensuring that your child attends these sessions regularly and treats them as a priority.
