Uniform Expectations

As part of the Grace Way, our expectations are that students wear their full school uniform to school every day. Uniform is an important part of the school's identity; it reinforces who we are as a community and helps allow students to feel pride in their school. As per our school uniform policy, trousers must be tailored school trousers with a zip or button fastening, hanging below the ankle. Trousers cannot be made from legging material or be "fashion style" trousers.

Skirts should be pleated, hang loose from the waist and must be knee length.


Shoes should be plain black leather shoes.
