Year	Topic(s)	Why this? Why now?
Year 7	Shoe Project	<p>Students will be introduced to applying tone using a pencil and practicing changing their pressure. During the shoe project, students will practice their observational skills to gain an accurate outline that is to scale and are in proportion. This will help the students build the foundation on the step by step process on achieving an accurate recording.</p>
Year 8	African Project	<p>Students will learn about the history and geographical culture of Africa and how different materials and techniques have been applied and how it has influenced artists around the world. Students will be applying and embellishing cardboard relief techniques through proportion and symmetry.</p>
Year 9	Food Project	<p>Students will build on analysing their own and their peer's artwork through critical extended writing. Students will be introduced to a hyper realistic artist who blends and mixes colours through smooth application.</p>

		Students will learn how to do this with success and apply to their own response.
Year 10	Coursework - personal investigation	Students are continuing to build on their skills they have learnt in Term 1. Students have chosen their own personal theme and are exploring multiple pathways to create a final outcome.
Year 11	Coursework and Exam Prep	Students will be entering their exam preparations. Using the skills they have learnt from Year 10 to term 1 Year 11, students will prepare for the exam after the April half term.
