

Subject: Art

Term 3 (Apr - Jul)

This term we are studying...

Year	Topic(s)	Why this? Why now?
Year 7	Landscapes	Students will be exploring perspective, features of a landscape and exploring artists who throughout history have produced landscape artwork. Students will apply a range of materials and techniques inspired by these artists.
Year 8	Cubism	Students will learn about the art movements Cubism. They will apply the knowledge they have learnt on Colour Theory to select colours that complement each other and the application to geometric shapes. This will support in confidence building and problem solving when creating a final composition.
Year 9	Architecture	Students will be exploring artists and designers within this project to develop their skills in perspective drawing. They will use prior knowledge from Year 8 using tonal range to create a three dimensional recordings. Students will produce a final response that shows a strong connection to an artist(s) they have explored.
Year 10	Independent Graphic Design	Students will be provided with a theme from exam papers in order to familiarise themselves with the exam process. Students will use their previous knowledge of independent research through artist analysis, observational recordings and development through the

		use of different materials against the OCR Assessment Objectives
Year 11	Personal Investigation and Exam	Students will receive exam papers in January. Preparation for Component 2 (externally set task) Students will respond to one topic out of five themes and develop ideas using, research the work of artists and crafts people. And collating a selection of work using a range of materials.
